

## Introduction

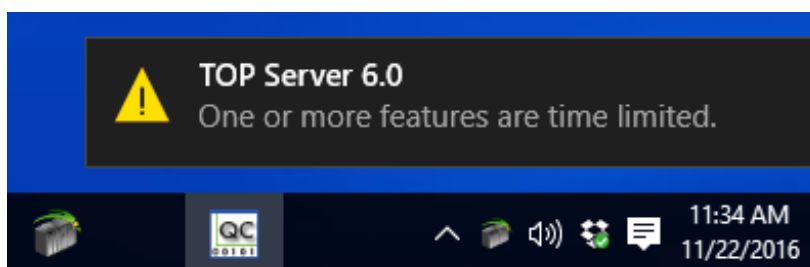
For TOP Server V6 installed on Windows 10, if you're running in trial mode, there are flag notifications from the system tray that appear periodically with a sound.

If you're planning to use trial mode for further testing and would prefer to disable these notifications, this document provides step-by-step details on how to turn off these trial notifications in the Windows OS.

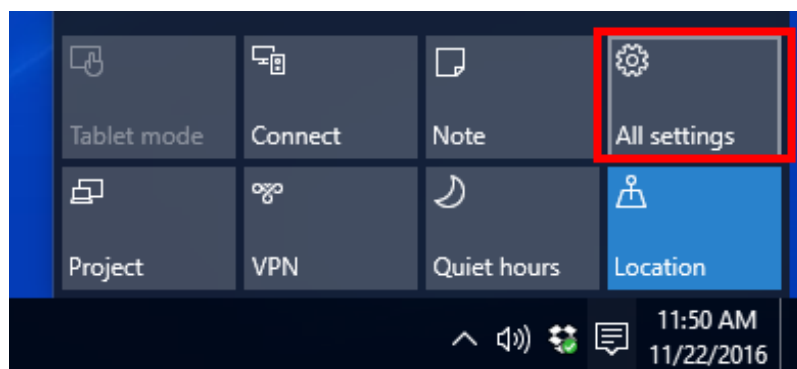
## How-to Disable Windows 10 Notifications for TOP Server V6 Admin

To disable application notifications in Windows 10 for TOP Server V6, please follow the steps below:

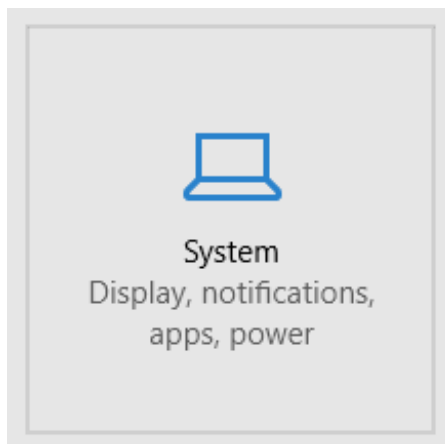
1. Click on the Flag icon in the Windows system tray.



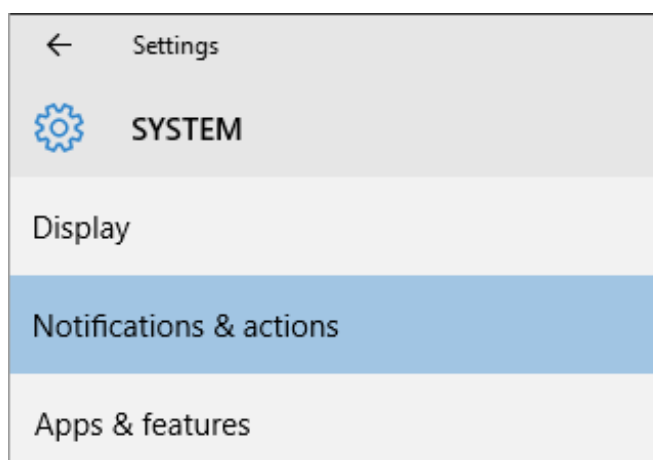
2. Select the "All Settings" option.



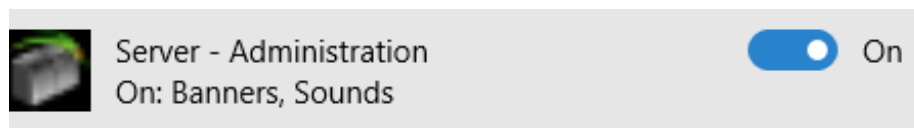
3. Select the "System - Display, notifications, apps, power" option.



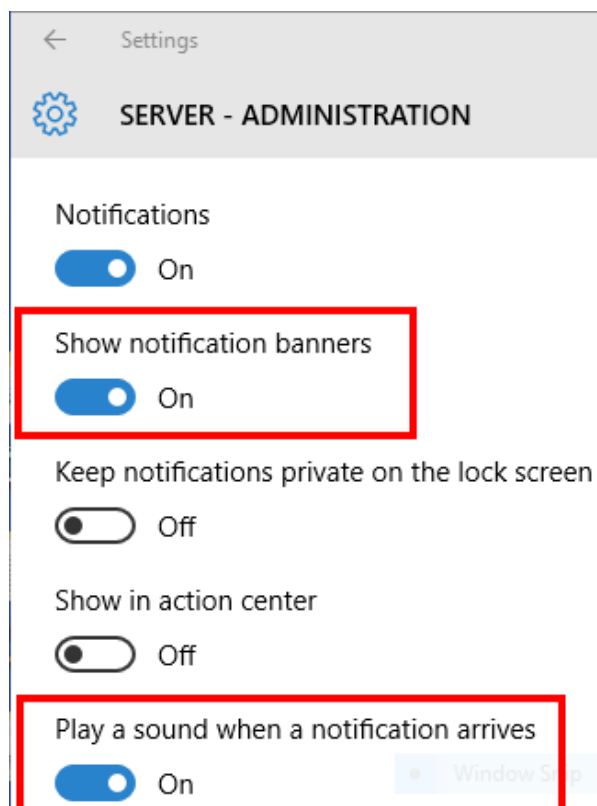
4. Select the "Notifications & actions" option from the left menu bar.



5. Scroll down under the "Show notifications from these apps" section until you find "Server - Administration" in the list.



6. You can disable all notifications here by simply toggling the setting to "Off".
7. For more granular notification options, click on "Server - Administration".
8. In the detailed notification settings, you can set "Play a sound when a notification arrives" to "Off" if you only want the sound to be disable or you can also set "Show notification banners" to "Off" if you also want the visual flags to stop, as well.



## Conclusion

Make sure to re-enable these notifications upon licensing TOP Server V6. Leaving these settings disabled permanently could potentially result in missing other important warnings or notifications.
